- For all real numbers  $a$  and  $b$ , let  $a \otimes b = (a-5)(b+3)$ . Let  $k$  be the number of sides of a convex polygon whose sum of the degree measures of its interior angles is 2160. Find the value of  $(7 \otimes 20) + k$ .
